

INCOME MEANS TESTING FOR THE WOMEN'S RETURN TO WORK GRANTS PROGRAM

Income may be assessed via evidence provided from your

- tax assessment or
- Centrelink evidence such as a Health Care Card or a Low Income Health Care Card.

The income means test is based on gross income. See table below for maximum income level to apply for Return to Work grant.

Status	Weekly Income	Annual Income
Single or couple combined, one child	\$971.25	\$50,505.00
Two children	\$1013.75	\$52,715.00
Three children	\$1056.25	\$54,925.00
Four Children	\$1098.75	\$57,135.00
Five Children	\$1141.25	\$59,345.00
Six Children	\$1183.75	\$61,555.00

For each additional child an additional \$42.50 per fortnight may be added to maximum income.

You must also provide supporting evidence to confirm residency in the ACT for at least the previous three months. One of the following documents may be provided:

- Residential tenancy agreement/Lease agreement. If you are boarding or lodging, a statutory declaration may be presented confirming place of residency.
- Utility Bills, such as electricity, gas, phone etc.
- Driver's licence.
- Bank statements.
